Hasina-Modi talks today: Defence to connectivity, water to power on table

New Delhi, June 21

LESS THAN TWO weeks after she came to New Delhi for the swearing-in ceremony of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and the Union Council of Ministers, Bangladesh Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina returned to the Capital Friday on a two-day State visit and met External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar.

A bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Modi is scheduled Saturday with a range of topics on the table – defence, connectivity and infrastructure, power and energy cooperation, trade and economic partnership, development cooperation, river water-sharing and cultural ties.

This is the first incoming bilateral State visit by a foreign leader after the formation of the new government following the Lok Sabha elections.

From Bangladesh's perspective, the long-pending Teesta water-sharing pact will be on the agenda.

Hasina was among seven leaders from India's neighbourhood and the Indian Ocean region who attended the swearing-in ceremony at the Rashtrapati Bhawan on June 9.

Apart from holding bilateral consultations with Modi, she is scheduled to call on President Droupadi Murmu and Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar.

Officials said that India and Bangladesh "share deep-rooted bonds of history, language, cul-

ture, and multitude of other commonalities. The outstanding nature of bilateral ties is reflected in an all-encompassing partnership based on sovereignty, equality, trust, and understanding. This partnership has evolved as a model for bilateral relations for the entire region and beyond".

On economic and trade partnership, Bangladesh is India's biggest trade partner in South Asia and India is the second biggest trade partner of Bangladesh in Asia. India is Bangladesh's largest export destination in Asia, with approximately \$2 billion of Bangladeshi exports to India in FY23. Sources said the two sides are expected to discuss a more balanced trade and new opportunities for investment.

On defence cooperation, sources said that the two countries share 4096.7 km of border; the longest land boundary that India shares with any of its neighbours.

"There is active cooperation between various agencies of both countries working together to cooperate on police matters, anti-corruption activities and combat the issues of illicit drug trafficking, fake currency, human trafficking, among others. The two countries engage in regular bilateral defence interactions and engagements," sources said, adding that Delhi and Dhaka will discuss more opportunities in the defence sector as well.

Cooperation in the power and energy sectors has become one of the crucial pillars of India-Bangladesh relations in recent years, and Bangladesh is currently importing 1160 MW of power from India, sources said.

The India-Bangladesh Friendship Pipeline for carriage of High Speed Diesel from India to Bangladesh was inaugurated by the two Prime Ministers in March 2023.

EC sets ball rolling for J&K elections, electoral rolls to be revised by Aug 20

THE ELECTION COMMISSION (EC) has kicked off preparations for holding Assembly elections in Jammu and Kashmir, as well as in Haryana, Jharkhand, and Maharashtra.

The poll panel announced Friday that revised electoral rolls in these states and Union Territory would be published by August 20.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi had said in Srinagar on Thursday that statehood would soon be returned to J&K and that preparations for Assembly elections in the UT are underway.

According to sources, the EC wrote to Chief Electoral Officers of the poll-bound states and UT on Thursday, informing them of the schedule of the special summary revision of electoral rolls. The EC is also holding training for officials of these states and UT in New Delhi this week.

In a statement on Friday, the EC said the pre-special summary revision exercises, including rationalising the locations of polling stations to make them more convenient, will start on June 25.

The electoral rolls will be updated with July 1 as the cut-off for new voters to register, and the draft rolls will be published on July 25, the EC said. After this, electors have the chance to file claims and objections till August 9. The publication of the final electoral rolls will be done by August 20, as per the schedule.

Assembly elections have not been held in J&K since 2018, when the Assembly in what was then a state was dissolved. In 2019, the state was reorganised into two Union Territories – J&K and Ladakh – and the special status provided to the state under Article 370 of the Constitution was repealed.


While upholding the abrogation of special status, the Supreme Court had last year ordered the Election Commission to hold Assembly elections in J&K by September 30, 2024. Chief Election Commissioner Rajiv Kumar had said earlier this month that the poll panel would start the process of conducting the elections "very soon".

On Thursday, the PM said at an event in Srinagar, "Preparations for Assembly elections have begun. The day is not far when the people of Jammu and Kashmir will vote to elect their government."

The EC on Friday said, "General election to the Legislative Assembly of UT of J&K is also to be conducted for constituting a new House after delimitation of constituencies. Witnessing the huge participation of the people of Jammu and Kashmir in the recently concluded Lok Sabha Elections, the Commission has also directed for the update of the electoral rolls in the UT of J&K with July 1, 2024 as the qualifying date."

In the recent Lok Sabha elections, J&K saw an overall turnout of 58.58 per cent – the highest in 35 years.

ED acting like it has enmity with Kejriwal, alleges AAP

THE ENFORCEMENT DIRECTORATE (ED) was struggling to keep its case of alleged money laundering linked to the excise policy afloat at various courts, the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) alleged after the Delhi High Court stayed the bail granted to Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal by a trial court a day earlier.

Reacting to the AAP's allegations, the BJP termed them hasty and accused the party and its leaders of excelling in "spreading confusion" when it came to such matters. It said generally, every investigative agency challenges bail granted to an accused and this was what was happening in Kejriwal's case as well.

Moving the High Court a day after a city court granted bail to the AAP convener, the ED Friday termed the bail order "illegal, erroneous and arbitrary" and argued that it was "a fit case where stay should be granted". Appearing for Kejriwal, Senior Advocate Vikram Chaudhari termed the order "most well formulated" and fit to "qualify in all spheres the tests of equity and justice."

A single-judge bench of Justice Sudhir Kumar Jain said, "Arguments are heard. Order is reserved. Till the pronouncement of the order on the stay application, the operation of the impugned (trial court) order is stayed". This means that the CM would have to remain in jail for now.

The HC said that it wants to go through the "entire record, the impugned judgment" and it shall pronounce its verdict on the stay application in "two-three days".

Senior AAP leader and Delhi minister Saurabh Bharadwaj said at a press conference after the HC's decision: "What a Central agency has said in court today about the judge who granted bail to Kejriwal is shameful... The ED is not being able to submit any proof to the courts... the AAP has been saying this consistently – this has also been noted in the trial court order (granting bail to Kejriwal)."
