Bit by bit, scientists gain round against the epidemic called AIDS

The London patient's cure might have got more attention in the past, but recent advances more likely to affect course of the AIDS epidemic

THE NEW YORK TIMES March 9 THE UNNAMED "LONDON patient" — the second person apparently cured of HIV — earned all the headlines. But other research released this week at the Conference on Retroviruses and Opportunistic Infections showed that scientists are making slow but steady progress on the tactics and medicines needed to fight the epidemic, especially in Africa. Monthly injections of long-acting HI drugs proved as good as daily pills at sup-

pressing the virus, according to two trials involving more than 1,000 patients. In a newer study, Descovy, a new formulation of the HIV treatment Truvada, proved just as effective at suppressing the virus, and may have fewer — or at least different — side effects. A study of the "test and treat" strategy in one million people in South Africa and Zambia — the largest HI prevention study ever conducted — produced mixed results. Offering widespread home testing plus treatment to the sickest patients did reduce the number of new infections. But offering immediate treatment to all did not help as much as had been expected. And a study of pregnant women in Uganda and South Africa showed that a relatively new drug, dolutegravir, was better than the standard treatment for

women about to give birth. The results of those trials were revealed at the CROI meeting in Seattle, a scientific conference held each year in the United States. It tends to offer more research and fewer theatrics than the International AIDS Society conferences that move to new cities around the globe every two years. Proving that injectable HIV drugs work is important because many people forget to take their daily pills or cannot keep pills in their homes. The success of the two injectable drug studies — named Atlas and Flair — raised hopes among HIV experts that these shots may eventually be used to protect the uninfected. (Trials testing that idea are underway now, but results are not expected for about three years.) We'll bring you stories that capture the wonders of

the human body, nature and the cosmos. Doctors working in poor countries are eager for injections or implants that will release small daily doses of anti-retroviral drugs because the devices can be used in secrecy. Providing injections may be harder than handing out pills, but the option may attract patients with HIV who would otherwise stay away. African women often say they cannot be caught with pills, microbicides, vaginal rings or other anti-HIV measures because they fear that their husbands, lovers, family members or neighbours will mistakenly assume they are infected. Long-lasting contraceptive injections like Depo-Provera are much more popular in Africa than in the United States because many women must conceal birth control from their partners, who may get angry that they do not want more children. Similarly, many gay or bisexual men would welcome a discreet way to take HIV drugs because they are hiding from their spouses or families that they have sex with men. Both studies tested monthly injections of cabotegravir and rilpivirine deep into the buttocks. The shots worked, and only a handful of participants dropped out complaining they were too painful. Post-trial surveys found that 98% of the subjects preferred injections to pills.

GOOGLE CONTROLS MANY of the ways businesses access customers online in the US, making it almost impossible to run a company without buying advertising from the internet giant. As politicians increase scrutiny of large technology companies, Google's lock on these digital relationships is becoming a potential liability, not just a lucrative advantage praised each quarter by Wall Street analysts. Presidential candidate and Senator Elizabeth Warren outlined a proposal Friday for breaking up Alphabet Inc's Google — and Facebook Inc and Amazon.com Inc — because they have "too much power" and have "bulldozed competition."

While consumers pay nothing for most Google services, some businesses say they often can't avoid giving more money to the company because the internet giant is the main source of answers when Americans go online to get information. Google has more than 81% of the mobile search market, according to research firm NetMarketShare. While Facebook matches advertisers with people interested in certain topics, Google can tell what a person really wants, right as that person types their query into the search bar. Showing up at the top of search results is imperative for most companies and in recent years Google has changed its software, especially on smartphones, to make buying ads the best way to achieve that goal. It's not possible to run a

"Google has dominance in search, it's utterly completely dominant," said Brian Wieser, president of business intelligence for GroupM, the media investment management arm of advertising giant WPP Plc. The Federal Trade Commission closed an antitrust investigation into Google in 2013 but there's been a rising chorus of voices on the political left and right demanding Google be cut down to size, somehow. Nowhere is Google's power more pervasive — and potentially damaging to businesses — than in the esoteric market for "branded keywords." This is where businesses buy ads based on their brand names. So Lyft bids on the word "Lyft" and when people search for that, Google runs an ad at the top of results usually linking to the ride-sharing company's website.
